The National Aviation Heritage Area encompasses an eight-county area in Ohio and is the Birthplace of Aviation from the Wright brothers to Neil Armstrong. Designated by Congress, we are the recognized global center of aviation heritage. Our 15+ aviation sites represent the first practical airplane, the world's oldest and largest military aviation museum, the Golden Age of Aviation, and the home of the world's most famous astronaut. Take a flight in the Wright "B" Flyer, a WWII bomber, or an open-cockpit biplane. Try your hand at restoring an aircraft with volunteer crews, visit hundreds of planes on display, and take a quiet stroll at the Wright brothers' final resting place in an accredited arboretum. Journey back in time to discover Dayton's earliest neighborhood! SunWatch is the site of an 800-year-old American Indian Village situated along the banks of the Great Miami River. Discovered by local amateur archaeologists, the site has been excavated and studied since 1968, and was opened to the public in 1989. SunWatch features an Interpretive Center and reconstructed Village, as well as prairie with native grasses and other plants.
